What you should know about adopting a Foxhunt White Shepherd Puppy



~ Typical Foxhunt White Shepherds Puppies ~

The price for our puppies is \$800.00 for "pet quality" (limited registration) and \$1200.00 for "show/breed quality" (full registration). First pick of the litter is \$1500.00. Let me know if you need me to explain the difference between limited and full registration, I will be happy to do so. Please understand that show/breed quality puppies are chosen first. This is to assure that the best conformation puppies are sent out for breeding purposes, this helps insure the future of our wonderful dogs. The pet puppies are chosen in the order the reservations are received. This includes the puppies AWSA registration, UKC puppy papers, AKC puppy papers, 2 vet checks including shots & health certificate, micro chip & tag, collar, ear tattoo & puppy packet with your [puppy contract](#), vaccination record, [temperament evaluation results](#), puppy registration papers, your puppy's pedigree, microchip & tattoo numbers, Purina ONE puppy food sample & lots of information pertaining to training your puppy and the White Shepherd breed. We

also include a CD of all your puppy's baby pictures & videos. I take a lot of pictures as they growing and take videos once a week. Your puppy will also have a web page on our site that we will update weekly while he/she is here with us, we will continue to update your puppy's page whenever you send us updates after he/she goes home. I love each and every puppy I produce, I spend a lot of time with my babies and believe strongly in Early Neurological Stimulation. Check it out here: <http://breedingbetterdogs.com/achiever.html> and do these exercises daily with the babies, this also allows me to check over each puppy daily. Also each puppy's weight is checked every week to be sure everyone's growing well & healthy. All of my babies are raised inside my home, I have 2 whelping kennels just off my bedroom with cameras so that I can monitor the babies almost constantly.

All interested parties must first fill out a Puppy Adoption Application. Once you are approved and we have received your deposit & signed [puppy contract](#) you will be placed on our puppy wish list. You will be notified as soon as the next breeding takes place. We will notify you again when the puppies have arrived.

Deposits are \$100.00 for pet/limited registration and \$200.00 for breed/full registration along with your signed puppy contract. Your deposit is fully refundable until the litter is born. Once the litter is on the ground your deposit becomes non refundable. If for some reason when the pups are 8 weeks old, if you don't find a puppy that suites you in the litter (you must choose your puppy by 7 weeks of age) we will gladly hold your deposit until the next litter and allow you to choose from that litter instead.

Foxhunt puppies are very versatile with good temperaments and will do well as show, performance, working, service or pet dogs. Our puppies are available free of charge (on limited registration) to persons or organizations needing service/working dogs, such as for but not limited to police work of any kind, Search and Rescue work or for persons with disabilities. Different paperwork needs to be filled out and a doctor's note furnished (for disabilities puppies only) to apply for these puppies. We do require a yearly update and photo (that may be used on our website) on all service/working puppies we donate. As far as genetic health goes, please understand that all dogs have 7.2 genetic defects. We strive greatly for the best genetic health we can produce, nothing however, is 100% and anybody that tries to tell you differently is a liar, plain and simple. Some breeders (of any breed of dog) may choose close their eyes to the genetics of their lines, we here at Foxhunt White Shepherds embrace the idea of genetic charting, by charting every litter before we do a breeding. We, the breeders of this magnificent white dog have a wonderful resource for this, the "White Shepherd Genetic Project" is a wonderful tool we have at our fingertips and is a world re noun website. All our dogs are OFAed and/or PennHipped

before breeding and our Puppy Contract is one of the best in the dog world. We are also involved in any and all genetic research pertaining to our wonderful breed. Genetics and temperament are of the utmost importance to us here at Foxhunt White Shepherds. But even with all our careful planning and precautions every once in awhile some genetic problem, hidden in the lines will rear it's ugly head. :o(That's why we feel the need to have such an in depth contract that covers the genetics of our puppies as well as other aspects of importance to all the parties concerned including the Foxhunt puppy. If you haven't read "[Our Puppy Contract](#)" I urge you to do so, it does expect responsibility on both the part of the breeder and the puppy buyer.

We feed Purina ONE puppy food, I have used this puppy & dog food for my dogs for over 10 years and I highly recommend it. You will receive a sample of it for your puppy in your puppy packet.

Shipping runs approx. \$175.00 - \$200.00 (we will call and get an exact price when the time is close to shipping) plus the cost of an airline crate which runs about \$40.00. The cheapest place I've found them is Walmart. Your puppy will ship on Delta airlines out of Dothan Regional Airport in Dothan, Alabama. I do not charge any extra for shipping other than \$20.00 to cover my gas to the airport, it's about a 80 mile round trip for me. If I will be shipping your puppy I will send the puppy packet to you a week before the puppy ships out, so that you will have everything in time for your new baby's arrival.

We do not allow our puppies to leave before 9 1/2 weeks of age if being picked up and not before 10 weeks if being shipped. This allows us to get 2 (4 way puppy shots consisting of Parvo, Distemper, Hepatitis & Parainfluenza and also a Bordatella vaccine on the second veterinarian visit) into them before they leave and gives them a few days after receiving their vaccines to be sure there's no reaction such as loose stools, fever, ect. We want to be sure your baby arrives to you happy & healthy.



Once you purchase a Foxhunt puppy we're here for you, to help in any way we can for the life of your puppy. We feel very responsible for each and every

puppy we produce and strive to be sure every Foxhunt puppy lives a happy and healthy life. Please feel free to contact us anytime.
